Summer Company is delivered by the Vaughan Business Enterprise Centre (VBEC) in partnership with the Ontario Ministry of Economic Development, Job Creation and Trade (MEDJCT).

Summer Company entrepreneurs are Ontario students between the ages of 15 and 29 years old who start and operate a full-time business over the summer. Program participants receive training from VBEC, mentorship from business leaders in the community and access to a provincial grant of up to \$3,000 to invest in starting their business.

We look forward to seeing our 2019 Summer Company students grow as entrepreneurs!



2018 Summer Company Recap

Highlights of the 2018 program include:

- · nine community mentors offered support, expertise and mentorship.
- · 30 full-time summer jobs created by the program participant.
- \$7,200 average in gross revenue from June to August generated by the participating entrepreneurs.
- 16 out of the 17 participants continued to run their companies part time during the 2018/19 school year.
